

RESOLUTION 2015-092

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA; APPROVING THE TERMS OF SETTLEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER, CITY CLERK, CITY ATTORNEY OR THEIR DULY AUTHORIZED OFFICERS AND AGENTS TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES AND INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, On August 5, 2014, Kathleen Hall filed a civil lawsuit (Cochise County Case No. CV2014-00513) against the City, Officer Brian Sebastian and the City of Sierra Vista Police Department for injuries she incurred as a result of an automobile accident with Officer Sebastian; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Hall and the City have agreed to certain Terms of Settlement in the matter; and

WHEREAS, before the City Attorney and City Manager may finalize the Terms of the Settlement, the Mayor and Council must direct him to do so; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Sierra Vista that such legal action be taken.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

That the settled policy, which directs the City Attorney and City Manager to finalize settlement terms in cases in which the City has been named as a defendant by specific action of the Mayor and City Council be, and hereby is reaffirmed.


SECTION 2


