### ***Who are the EAC?***

The Environmental Affairs Commission (EAC) was established in 1993. The purpose of the Commission is to advise the City Council on environmental issues, programs, and procedures relating to: reduction, reuse, recycling, water and energy conservation, environmental stewardship.

The EAC advocates sustainability, alternative fuel use, water conservation and community environmental outreach and education. As such, the City through the EAC recognizes noteworthy conservation accomplishments through the annual EMA.

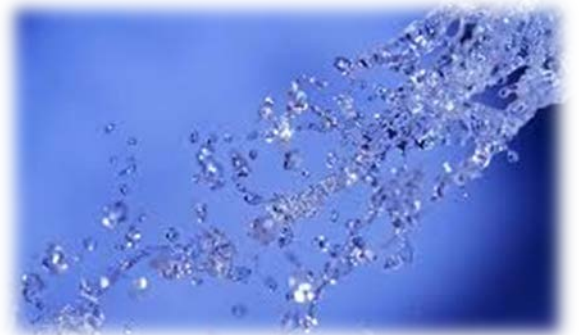
### ***What is EMA?***

EMA stands for Environmental Merit Award

The definition of “environmental” in the simplest of terms:  
“relating to or associated with the environment.”

### ***EMA Award Categories***

- Achievement in energy efficiency or conservation
- Achievement in water efficiency or conservation
- Renewable energy program
- Recycling materials for actual re- use



Recipients of the Award must be residents of, or businesses and organizations operating within, the city limits of Sierra Vista.
