The City of Sierra Vista has been awarded a Grant through the U.S. Department of Defense Office of Economic Adjustment (Grant No. EN872-20-01) and will accept competitive sealed proposals from qualified firms or organizations (herein referred to as firm) to conduct a Joint Resource Utilization Study (JRUS) identifying the joint resource utilization of land, airspace, and electromagnetic spectrum to sustain the Army's current and future missions at Fort Huachuca in a compatible use with local communities within the area's region of influence defined as Buffalo Soldier Electronic Test Range (BSETR) and restricted airspace R2303. Local partners and jurisdictions include: The City of Sierra Vista, Cochise County, Huachuca City, Santa Cruz County, and the State of Arizona.

A non-mandatory pre-proposal conference call has been scheduled for August 6th, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. Arizona Time. Interested firms may dial into (520) 452-7050 and use Code 2207 to join the call.

Sealed proposals shall be received until 2:00 p.m., Arizona Time, August 17th, 2020, in the Office of the Chief Procurement Officer, 1011 North Coronado Drive, Sierra Vista, Arizona 85635, at which time the proposals shall be opened and the name of each responding firm shall be publicly read.
