FY 2017 CAPER

The Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER) is a tool used to close the loop of actual performance with the Five-Year Consolidated Plan's (ConPlan) identified five-year goals and objectives. The Annual Action Plan (AAP) provides a concise summary of the actions and activities and the specific federal and non-federal resources planned for use each year to address the priority needs and specific goals that the current ConPlan identifies. **The CAPER is where we report the accomplishments and progress toward both the ConPlan's and AAP's goals, activities, and actions. The CAPER summarizes the information for HUD and citizens so they can easily assess the progress towards meeting the long-term ConPlan goals. The 2017 CAPER will report on the City's achievements toward the 2015 and 2016 Annual Action Plans for the period July 1, 2016, and June 30, 2017.**

2015 CDBG. The City's FY 2015 CDBG Annual Action Plan provided for the following projects: (1) accessibility improvements by reconstructing the pathway into Soldiers Creek Park; (2) Infrastructure improvements by constructing curb, gutter, and sidewalk along the north side of Taylor from N. Garden Ave. to North Ave; and (3) Infrastructure improvements by installing five solar streetlights (one at Ryan and N. Carmichael, one at Evans and Taylor Dr., and three in City areas of Theater Dr.).

2016 CDBG. The City's FY 2016 CDBG Annual Action Plan provided for the following projects: (1) Streetlights in the Fry Townsite and Sulger Neighborhoods; (2) Emergency Home Repairs; (3) Roof on Samaritan Station at Good Neighbor Alliance.
